A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO SUBMIT TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF MONTANA AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE V,

SECTION 3, OF THE MONTANA CONSTITUTION TO CHANGE THE TERM OF OFFICE OF A MEMBER OF THE MONTANA HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

FROM 2 YEARS TO 4 YEARS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Article V, section 3, of the Montana constitution is amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. Election and terms. A member of the house of representatives shall be elected for a term of two years and a member of the senate shall be elected for a term of four years each to begin on a date provided by law. One-half of the senators and representatives shall be elected every two years."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Submission to electorate.

This amendment shall be submitted to the electors of the state of Montana at the general election to be held November 4, 1980, by printing on the ballot the full title of this act and the following:

FOR a 4-year-term for a member of the house of representatives.

AGAINST a 4-year-term for a member of the house of representatives.
