HB 576 REFERENCE BILL

## SENATE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

That House Bill No. 596, third reading bill, be amended as follows:

1. Page 1, line 13 through line 16.
Following: "elector"

Strike: remainder of line 13 through "card" on line 16

Insert: "If the elector is registered with a first and middle name, the use of an initial instead of either the first or middle name, but not both names, need not disqualify the signature,"

2. Page 1, line 16. Following: "may"

Strike: "nevertheless"
