Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

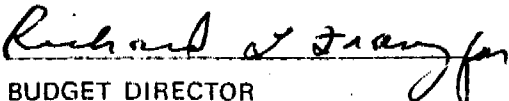
DESCRIPTION OF LEGISLATION:

House Bill 610 increases Jurors' Fees in courts not of record from \$7.50 to \$12.00 per day.

LOCAL IMPACT:

Since Jurors' fees in civil actions are paid by the losing party in the action, this bill would effect local government costs only for criminal trials held in Justice Courts and City Courts.

Based on a telephone survey sampling of Justice and City Courts, it is estimated that such courts hold a total of 1000 trials per year on criminal actions. The added cost per trial under this bill would be \$58,50 (13 x (\$12-\$7.50)), or an estimated total of \$58,500 per year.
