 4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT A TAVERN
 5 KEEPER OR EMPLOYEE FROM EXTENDING CREDIT TO TAVERN PATRONS
 6 BY "RUNNING A TAB" OR OTHER INFORMAL MEANS."

 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Informal extension of credit to tavern
 10 patrons prohibited. No licensee or employee of a licensee
 11 licensed under this code to sell an alcoholic beverage for
 12 on-premises consumption may extend credit to a patron for
 13 the purchase of an alcoholic beverage unless each such
 14 extension is based upon a prior written agreement and
 15 specifically acknowledged by the signature of the patron.

16 Section 2. Codification. Section 1 is intended to be
 17 codified as an integral part of Title 16, chapter 6, and the
 18 provisions contained in Title 16, chapters 1 through 6,
 19 apply to section 1.
