Informal extension of credit to tavern 10 patrons prohibited. No licensee or employee of a licensee 11 licensed under this code to sell an alcoholic beverage for on-premises consumption may extend credit to a patron for 12 13 the purchase of an alcoholic beverage unless each such 14 extension is based upon a prior written agreement and 15 specifically acknowledged by the signature of the patron. Section 2. Codification. Section 1 is intended to be 16 17 codified as an integral part of Title 16, chapter 6, and the provisions contained in Title 16, chapters 1 through 6, 18 19 apply to section 1. -End-
