INTRODUCED BY *Hammer*

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROHIBITING ANY CITY, TOWN, OR COUNTY FROM ADOPTING STRICTER SHIELDING STANDARDS FOR MOTOR VEHICLE WRECKING FACILITIES OR GRAVEYARDS THAN STATE STANDARDS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. City, town, or county shielding standards. No city, town, or county, whether exercising self-government or general government powers, may require compliance with stricter shielding standards for motor vehicle graveyards or motor vehicle wrecking facilities than those set by this part or by rules adopted by the department.

Section 2. Codification. (1) Section 1 is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 75, chapter 10, part 5, and the provisions contained in Title 75, chapter 10, part 5, apply to section 1.

(2) If section 1 is not codified in Title 75, chapter 10, part 5, the code commissioner shall add to the MCA, if necessary, statutory language to convey the intent of this section.
