Section 1. Registration of school buses purchased for other purposes -- markings removed -- inspection. (1) A purchaser of a school bus to be used for purposes other than transporting pupils to and from school or for school functions must, before the bus may be registered, remove all markings visible to an observer outside the bus that identify it as a school bus, including but not limited to the chrome yellow color, the four amber alternately flashing prewarning signal lights, the four red alternately flashing warning signal lights, and any words or insignia designating the bus as a school bus.

(2) The application for registration must be accompanied by an inspection certificate issued by the highway patrol stating that all school bus markings have been removed as required by this section. The highway patrol
