10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Registration of school buses purchased for
12 other purposes -- markings removed -- inspection. (1) A
13 purchaser of a school bus to be used for purposes other than
14 transporting pupils to and from school or for school
15 functions must, before the bus may be registered, remove all
16 markings visible to an observer outside the bus that
17 identify it as a school bus, including but not limited to
18 the chrome yellow color, the four amber alternately flashing
19 prewarning signal lights, the four red alternately flashing
20 warning signal lights, and any words or insignia designating
21 the bus as a school bus.

22 (2) The application for registration must be
23 accompanied by an inspection certificate issued by the
24 highway patrol stating that all school bus markings have
25 been removed as required by this section. The highway patrol

1 shall make the necessary provisions for performing the
2 inspection and issuing certificates of compliance.

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT PURCHASERS OF SCHOOL BUSES FOR PURPOSES OTHER THAN USE AS SCHOOL BUSES MUST REMOVE ALL IDENTIFYING MARKINGS BEFORE THE BUS MAY BE REGISTERED AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE HIGHWAY PATROL INSPECT FOR COMPLIANCE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Registration of school buses purchased for other purposes -- markings removed -- inspection. (1) A purchaser of a school bus to be used for purposes other than transporting pupils to and from school or for school or PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SCHOOL OR FOR SCHOOL OR CHURCH functions must, before the bus may be registered, remove all markings visible to an observer outside the bus that identify it as a school bus, including but not limited to the chrome yellow color, the four amber alternately flashing prewarning signal lights, the four red alternately flashing warning signal lights, and any words or insignia designating the bus as a school bus.

(2) The application for registration must be accompanied by an inspection certificate issued by the highway patrol stating that all school bus markings have

~~been removed as required by this section. The highway patrol shall make the necessary provisions for performing the inspection and issuing certificates of compliance.~~

Section 2. Codification. This act is intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 61, chapter 3, part 3, and the provisions contained in Title 61 apply to this act.
