13	Section 1. Definition. "Team" means the prison medical
14	practices investigative team provided for in {section 2}.
15	Section 2. Prison medical practices investigative team
16	appointment and composition. (1) There is a prison
17	medical practices investigative team consisting of:
18	(a) a physician licensed to practice in Montana;
19	(b) a registered nurse licensed to practice in
20	Montana;
21	(c) a psychologist licensed to practice in Montana or
22	a psychiatrist licensed to practice medicine in Montana;
23	(d) a pharmacist licensed to practice in Montana;
24	(e) a dentist licensed to practice in Montana; and
25	(f) a criminologist with suitable academic

credentials.

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- (2) The members of the team shall be appointed by the 3 speaker and minority leader of the house of representatives and the president and minority leader of the senate in consultation professional 5 appropriate organizations.
- (3) The team is allocated to the department 7 administration for administrative purposes В prescribed in 2-15-121, except that 2-15-121(1)(c) does not apply. 10

Section 3. Compensation and expenses. A member of the team is not entitled to any compensation other than \$25 a day for each day he is actually engaged in the performance of the powers and duties prescribed in [section 4] and expenses as provided in 2-18-501 through 2-18-503.

Section 4. Powers and duties. (1) The team shall investigate medical practices in the state prison related to the members' respective professions, including the distribution and use of drugs. During the conduct of the investigation, the team must be given unrestricted access to all facilities in the prison and to any prisoner.

(2) The team shall make recommendations to 22 department of institutions and report to the 47th 23 legislature concerning the need for future quality control 25 of medical practices in the state prison.
