INTRODUCED BY BILL NO. 663

BY REQUEST OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO INCREASE THE FEE FOR
A MOTORBOAT LICENSE DECAL AND TO PROVIDE FOR ITS ALLOCATION;
AMENDING SECTION 23-2-512. MCA."

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 23-2-512. MCA, is amended to read:

"23-2-512. Identification number. (1) The owner of
each motorboat requiring numbering by this state shall file
an application for number in the office of the county
treasurer where the motorboat is owned or taxable on forms
prepared and furnished by the division of motor vehicles.
The application shall be signed by the owner of the
motorboat and shall be accompanied by a fee of \$\frac{1}{2}\$. Any
alteration, change, or false statement contained in the
application will render the certificate of number void. Upon
receipt of the application in approved form, the county
treasurer shall issue to the applicant a certificate of
number prepared and furnished by the division of motor
vehicles, stating the number awarded to the motorboat and
the name and address of the owner.

(2) Before filing the application with the county

treasurer, the applicant shall submit it to the county
assessor, who shall enter on the application, in a space to
be provided for that purpose, the market value and taxable
value of the motorboat for the year for which the
application for registration is made.

- (3) The applicant, upon the filing of the application, shall pay to the county treasurer the registration fee and the personal property taxes assessed against the motorboat or vessel for the current year of registration before the application for registration or reregistration may be accepted by the county treasurer.
- (4) Should the ownership of a motorboat change, a new application form with fee shall be filed within a reasonable time with the county treasurer and a new certificate of number awarded in the same manner as provided for in an original award of number.
- (5) If an agency of the United States government has in force a comprehensive system of identification numbering for motorboats in the United States, the numbering system employed pursuant to this part by the division of motor vehicles shall be in conformity.
- (6) Every certificate of number and the license decals awarded under this part shall continue in effect for a period not to exceed 1 year unless sooner terminated or discontinued in accordance with the provisions of this part.

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Certificates of number and license decals shall show the date of expiration and may be renewed by the owner in the same manner provided for in the initial securing of the certificate.

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- (7) Certificates of number shall expire on April 30 of each year and may not be in effect unless renewed under this part.
- (8) In event of transfer of ownership, the purchaser shall furnish the county treasurer notice within a reasonable time of the acquisition of all or any part of his interest, other than the creation of a security interest, in a motorboat numbered in this state or of the loss, theft, destruction, or abandonment of the motorboat. The transfer, loss, theft, destruction, or abandonment terminates the certificate of number for the motorboat. Recovery from theft or transfer of a part interest that does not affect the owner's right to operate the motorboat does not terminate the certificate of number.
- (9) A holder of a certificate of number shall notify the county treasurer within reasonable time if his address no longer conforms to the address appearing on the certificate and furnish the county treasurer with his new address. The division of motor vehicles may provide by rule for the surrender of the certificate bearing the former address and its replacement with a certificate bearing the

new address or the alteration of an outstanding certificate
to show the new address of the holder.

- (10) (a) The number awarded must be painted on or attached to each outboard side of the forward half of the motorboat ore if there are no such sides, at a corresponding location on both outboard sides of the foredeck of the motorboat. The number awarded shall read from left to right, be in Arabic numerals, in block characters of good proportion at least 3 inches tall excluding border or trim. of a color that contrasts with the color of the background, and be so maintained as to be clearly visible and legible. The number may not be placed on the obscured underside of the flared bow where it cannot be easily seen from another vessel or ashore. No numerals, letters, or devices, other than those used in connection with the identifying number issued, may be placed in the proximity of the identifying number. No numerals, letters, or devices which might interfere with the ready identification of the motorboat by its identifying number may be carried as to interfere with the motorboat's identification. No number other than the number and license decal awarded to a motorboat or granted reciprocity under this part shall be painted, attached, or otherwise displayed on either side of the forward half of the motorboat.
- (b) The certificate of number shall be pocket size and

available to federal, state, or local law enforcement officers at all reasonable times for inspection on the motorboat whenever the motorboat is on waters of this state.

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- (c) Boat liveries are not required to have the certificate of number on board each motorboat, but a rental agreement must be carried on board livery motorboats in place of the certificate of number.
- (11) Fees collected under this section shall be transmitted to the state treasurer who shall deposit the fees each fee in the motorboat-certificate-identification account-of-on earmarked revenue funds \$1 to the credit of the registrar of motor vehicles and \$1 to the credit of the motorboat certificate identification account. These fees shall be used only for the administration and enforcement of this part, as amended, including the operation of a water safety program by the department of fish and game.
- (12) An owner of a motorboat must within a reasonable time notify the division of motor vehicles, giving the motorboat's identifying number and the owner's name when that motorboat becomes documented as a vessel of the United States or is transferred, lost, destroyed, abandoned, or frauded or within 60 days after change of state of principal use."

In compliance with a written request received <u>February 9, 1979</u>, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for <u>House Bill 663</u> pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

### DESCRIPTION OF RPOPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 663 is legislation proposed to provide money for the administration and enforcement of the motorboat decal law by increasing the present fee of \$1.00 to the Department of Fish and Game for water safety and \$1.00 to the Department of Justice Registrar's Office for administration. Presently, the \$1.00 fee goes to the Department of Fish and Game for administration and enforcement of the motorboat safety program. Nothing to Registrars office for administration.

### **ASSUMPTIONS:**

- 1. 29,400 boats will be registered in FY 1980.
- 2. 30,000 boats will be registered in FY 1981.
