In compliance with a written request received February 9,1979 , there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for llouse Bill 663 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly, Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF RPOPOSED LEGISLATION:

- House Bill 663 is legislation proposed to provide money for the administration and enforcement of the motorboat decal law by increasing the present fee of $\$ 1.00$ to the Department of Fish and Game for water safety and $\$ 1.00$ to the Department of Justice Registrar's Office for administration. Presently, the $\$ 1.00$ fee goes to the Department of Fish and Game for administration and enforcement of the motorboat safety program. Nothing to Registrars office for administration.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. 29,400 boats will be registered in FY 1980.
2. 30,000 boats will be registered in FY 1981.

REVENUE IMPACT:
