9 Section 1. Section 15-57-109, MCA, is amended to read:

 11 money. The department of revenue may employ such clerical
 12 and field assistance as necessary to carry out and
 13 administer the provisions of this chapter. All money
 14 collected under the provisions of this chapter shall be paid
 15 into the state treasury, ~~with 65 of the fee collected from~~
 16 ~~each store license sold credited to an earmarked revenue and~~
 17 ~~credited to the general fund, for administration~~
 18 ~~Administration~~ of Title 30, chapter 14, part 2, by is the

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:


An act requiring the deposit of all revenue generated from the sale of store licenses into the General Fund.

ASSUMPTIONS:

The Unfair Practices Act administered by the Consumer Protection Division currently funded by an earmarked revenue fund account will be fully funded from the General Fund.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Additional General Fund revenues to be realized during the 1980-81 Biennium as a result of the proposed legislation -- \$210,623.
