 12 the report and statement of expenses, to transcribe in a
 13 book to be kept for that purpose all the facts contained in
 14 such report concerning such serviceman or servicewoman. It
 15 shall also be the duty of the clerk, upon receiving the
 16 report of the burial of such deceased person, to make
 17 application to the proper authorities under the government
 18 of the United States for a suitable headstone as provided by
 19 act of congress and to cause the same to be placed at the
 20 head of the grave of such serviceman or servicewoman, the
 21 expense of which shall not exceed the sum of ~~\$20~~ *\$30* for
 22 cartage of and properly setting up each stone. The expense
 23 thus incurred shall be audited and paid as provided in
 24 10-2-502 for the burial expenses."
