11. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12. Section 1. Section 50-6-102, MCA, is amended to read:  
13. "50-6-102. Department to establish and administer  
14. program — exception. (1) The department of health and  
15. environmental sciences shall establish and administer an  
16. emergency medical services program.

17. (2) The emergency medical services program may not  
18. include a program for emergency medical technicians."

19. NEW SECTION. Section 2. Department to establish and  
20. administer programs. The department of community affairs,  
21. highway safety division, shall establish and administer an  
22. emergency medical technician program in accordance with the  
23. provisions of Title 50, chapter 6, part 2 and Title 61,  
24. chapter 2, part 1.
