DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 696 is an act changing the county share in participation in the Aid to Dependent Children grants from 1/3 to 22.5% of the non-federal share.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The Federal Matching Assistance Percentage (FMAP) rate for FY80 is 36.515 and for FY81 is 35.72.
- 2. AFDC, non-resident General Assistance and Foster Care costs are based upon the Executive Budget request.
- 3. State paid (less than one year residency) AFDC and UF cases are 45% of the ward/state line item.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The proposed legislation will shift to the State General Fund from County Revolving Accounts costs of \$462,000 each year of the biennium.
