In compliance with a written request received March 8, 19 79, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 696 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly.

Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

House Bill 696 is an act changing the county share in participation in the Aid to Dependent Children grants from 1/3 to 22.5% of the non-federal share.

ASSUMPTIONS:


1. The Federal Matching Assistance Percentage (FMAP) rate for FY80 is 36.515 and for FY81 is 35.72.
2. AFDC, non-resident General Assistance and Foster Care costs are based upon the Executive Budget request.
3. State paid (less than one year residency) AFDC and UF cases are 45% of the ward/state line item.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The proposed legislation will shift to the State General Fund from County Revolving Accounts costs of \$462,000 each year of the biennium.
