 4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO CLARIFY THAT A
 5 RESIDENT OF REFUSE DISPOSAL DISTRICT WHO DOES NOT RECEIVE
 6 SERVICES FROM THE DISTRICT MAY NOT BE ASSESSED A FEE FOR THE
 7 SERVICE OR FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE
 8 DISTRICT; AMENDING SECTION 7-13-231, MCA."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 7-13-231, MCA, is amended to read:

11 "7-13-231. Authorization for charges for services. (1)
 12 To defray the cost of maintenance and operation of said
 13 refuse disposal district, the board shall establish a fee
 14 for service, with approval of the county commissioners.

15 (2) This fee shall be assessed to all units in the
 16 district that are receiving a service, for the purpose of
 17 maintenance and operation of said district.

18 (3) A person who resides in the refuse disposal
 19 district and who disposes of the refuse and waste generated
 20 by his family residential unit himself or by a private
 21 vendor may be excused any fees for the maintenance and
 22 operation of the district or for any refuse disposal service
 23 upon presenting a certificate signed by the county
 24 sanitarian that he has a site meeting the requirements of
