12 Section 1. Section 61-6-111, MCA, is amended to read:

 15 has been suspended hereunder, such registration shall not be
 16 transferred nor the motor vehicle in the respect of which

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 61-6-111, MCA, TO PROHIBIT AN OWNER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE WHOSE REGISTRATION HAS BEEN SUSPENDED FROM TRANSFERRING SUCH REGISTRATION OR MOTOR VEHICLE UNTIL THE JUDGMENT AGAINST HIM HAS BEEN STAYED OR SATISFIED IN FULL, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 61-6-111, MCA, is amended to read:
 "61-6-111. Transfer of registration ~~to defect purpose~~ ~~of part prohibited -- exceptions.~~ If an owner's registration has been suspended hereunder, such registration shall not be transferred nor the motor vehicle in the respect of which such registration was issued registered in any other name until ~~the division is satisfied that such transfer of registration is proposed in good faith and not for the purpose or with the effect of defeating the purposes of this~~ part a judgment as defined in 61-6-102(1) is stayed or satisfied in full, subject to the exceptions stated in 61-6-122 and 61-6-125, or until 6 years have passed from the date the judgment was first entered as provided in 25-9-301.
 Nothing in this section shall in anywise affect the rights

1 of any conditional vendor, chattel mortgagee, or lessor of a
 2 motor vehicle registered in the name of another as owner who
 3 becomes subject to the provisions of this section."
