Section 16-3-304, MCA, is amended to read: 11 \*16-3-304. Closing hours for licensed retail

12 establishments. All licensed establishments wherein 13 alcoholic beverages are sold, offered for sale, or given away at retail shall be closed each day between 2 a.m. and 8 14 a.m.; provided, however, that when any municipal 15 incorporation has by ordinance further restricted the hours 16 17 of sale of alcoholic beverages, then the sale of alcoholic 18 beverages is prohibited within the limits of any such city 19 or town during the time such sale is prohibited by this code 20 and in addition thereto during the hours that it is 21 prohibited by such ordinance. During such hours al) 22 alcoholic beverages must be placed under lock and key and 23 all persons except the owner and employees of such licensed 24 establishments shall be excluded therefrom except as provided in 16-3-305." 25
