## DESCRIPTION:

House Bill 741 is an act to amend section 61-5-101, MCA, to revise the powers and responsibilities of the Division of Motor Vehicles regarding the licensing of drivers.

## ASSUMPTIONS:

- The proposed legislation provides for a civilian examining force in lieu of a 1. officer examining force.
- 2. The Administrator of the Motor Vehicle Division will be responsible for the conversion from the uniformed officers to the civilian force.
