A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO GENERALLY REVISE THE LAW RELATING TO HIDE DEALERS; AMENDING SECTIONS 81-9-401. 81-9-402, AND 81-9-423, MCA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 81-9-401, MCA, is amended to read: #81-9-401. Definitions: (1) "Animal hide" means the hide of a horsey--morey-colty-multay-jacky-jenny-or-cuttle bovine, equine, mule, ass, sheep, goat, or swine of any age, sex, or breed.

- (2) "Hide certificate" means a certificate showing a transfer of ownership of animal hides.
- (3) "Hide dealer" or "buyer" means, for the purpose of this part, every person, firm, corporation, or association engaged in the business of buying or selling the--hide--or hides-of-any-cattle-or-of-any-horsey-marey-colty-muley-jacky or--jenny animal hides. However, licensed slaughterhouses shall not be deemed hide dealers or buyers.
- (4) "Inspector" means a sheriffy-deputy-sheriffy state stock inspector, or deputy state stock inspector, as defined in 81-3-201+ appointed by the department of livestock.
 - (5) "Seller" means a person selling or delivering

animal hides for or without a pecuniary consideration.*

Section 2. Section 81-9-402, MCA, is amended to read: "81-9-402. Hide certificate -- identification. (1) A seller of an animal hide shall obtain a hide certificate from the person receiving the hide. The department shall prescribe the form of the certificate, which shall include the marks and brands on each hide. The party receiving the hide must designate where it will be kept for 30 days following delivery. The certificate must be signed by the seller or his agent and the person receiving the hide.
