BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Liability furnishing alcoholic for beverages to intoxicated person. A person who suffers personal injury, property damage, or a loss of support proximately caused by the intoxication of another person or by such other person because of his intoxication has a cause of action against any third person who furnished or caused to be furnished alcoholic beverages to the intoxicated person in violation of 16-3-301(2)(b) or 16-6-304. The cause of action survives the death of the injured person, and the action may be brought by his representative. In any action brought under this section, the plaintiff may recover such damages as under all the circumstances of the case may be just, including exemplary damages.
