4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION  
5 7-32-4152, MCA, TO PROVIDE THAT THE MEMBERS ON A POLICE  
6 COMMISSION HEARING CHARGES BROUGHT AGAINST A POLICEMAN  
7 CONTINUE TO SIT ON THE COMMISSION FOR THAT BUSINESS UNTIL A  
8 DECISION HAS BEEN MADE."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Section 7-32-4152, MCA, is amended to read:

12 "7-32-4152. Term and compensation of members of police  
13 commission. (1) The appointees to the police commission  
14 shall hold office for 3 years, and one such member must be  
15 appointed annually at the first regular meeting of the city  
16 council or commission in May of each year. ~~However, a~~  
17 ~~member serving on the commission during the hearing or~~  
18 ~~deciding of a case under 7-32-4155 shall continue to serve~~  
19 ~~on the commission for that case until a decision has been~~  
20 ~~made; a new member may not sit on the commission for such~~  
21 ~~business.~~

22 (2) The compensation of the members of such board  
23 shall be fixed by the city council or commission, not to  
24 exceed \$10 per day or more than \$50 per month for any month  
25 for each member in cities of the first and second class."
