4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE
 5 TREATMENT OF INCARCERATED ALCOHOLICS AND DRUG USERS."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

8 Section 1. Treatment for incarcerated alcoholics and
 9 drug users. (1) Persons associated with a reputable public
 10 or private nonprofit organization involved with the
 11 rehabilitation and treatment of alcoholics and drug abusers
 12 may hold regular meetings and provide group or individual
 13 counseling for inmates of any jail or the state prison with
 14 the consent of the respective county sheriff or prison
 15 warden.

16 (2) If the organization is not permitted by the
 17 sheriff or warden to hold the meetings or provide
 18 counseling, it may petition the district court for authority
 19 to hold regular meetings and provide group or individual
 20 counseling. No less than 10 days prior to the hearing on the
 21 petition, a copy of the petition shall be served on the
 22 county attorney and sheriff of the county where the jail is
 23 located or on the warden of the state prison, as
 24 appropriate.

25 (3) Within 30 days after the hearing, the district

1 judge shall issue an order setting forth a time and other
 2 appropriate conditions under which meetings and individual
 3 counseling for alcoholism and drug abuse may be held in the
 4 jail or prison. The clerk of the district court shall charge
 5 no fee for filing of such petition or order.
