
In compliance with a written request received March 9, 1979, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 827 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to require the Public Employees' Retirement Division of the Department of Administration, in cooperation with the Legislative Council, to study the consolidation of the Montana Highway Patrolmen's Retirement System and the Montana State Game Warden's Retirement System as part of its 1980 actuarial evaluation and to report to the 1981 Legislature.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Public Employees' Retirement System would incur additional actuarial expenses of from \$2,000 to \$5,000 as a result of the proposed legislation, the funding for which would be provided from the Earmarked Revenue Fund.
