Contribution of cotenants for taxes. A joint tenant or tenant in common who pays more than a 14 proportionate share of the property tax on the jointly held 15 property is entitled to contribution from the other 16 cotenants for their proportionate share of the tax. 17 18 Section 2. Notice of payment of tax by cotenant. (1) A joint tenant or tenant in common may, within 30 days after 19 he pays more than his proportionate share of the property 20 21 tax on jointly held property, notify the other cotenants in

22 writing of their proportionate share of the tax.

23 (2) Notice under subsection (1) may be given by
24 certified mail.

25 Section 3. Lapse of joint interest -- action to quiet

title. (1) If a cotenant receives notice under [section 2]
 for 3 consecutive years and fails to pay his proportionate
 share of the property taxes within 3 years after receiving
 the first notice. his interest in the jointly held property
 lapses and vests in the cotenant who paid the tax for the
 3-year period.

7 (2) An action to quiet title to an interest in jointly
8 held property that has lapsed for failure to contribute may
9 be brought under the provisions of Title 70+ chapter 28.
