Section 1. Section 61-9-365. MCA. is amended to read:

"61-8-365. Putting refuse on highway prohibited. (1) No person shall throw or deposit upon any highway any glass

bottles, glass, nails, tacks, wire, cans, paper, or any

other substance likely to injure any person, animal, or

vehicle upon such highway. 14

- (2) Any person who drops or permits to be dropped or thrown upon any highway any destructive or injurious material shall immediately remove the same or cause it to be removed.
- (3) Any person removing a wrecked or damaged vehicle from a highway shall remove any glass or other injurious substance dropped upon the highway from such vehicle.
 - (4) A person convicted of violating this section shall be fined not less than \$50 or be imprisoned in the county iail for any term not to exceed 6 months, or both."
