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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 2-18-405, MCA, is amended to read:

"2-18-405. Payroll based on actual, end-of-period
figures -- pay date -- change of payroll periods. (1) By
January 1, 1979, all state central payroll systems shall be
based upon actual payroll figures submitted after the end of
the payroll period and may not be based upon estimated
payroll, except for salaried employees.

- (2) All state payroll systems shall provide for the fixing of payroll periods and designated days on which salaried employees shall be paid for the preceding payroll period. Such pay date shall be uniform for all employees of each state agency employed in the same geographic area and payroll warrants shall be distributed or mailed within 10 business days following the close of the payroll period.
 - (3) The payroll period of employees of a state agency

shall not be changed by inclusion of the agency into the

state central payroll system or by any fuvision or

modification of the system unless notice of the proposed

change has been given to each employee who will be affected

by such change in the form and manner prescribed by the

state auditor not less than 60 days prior to the effective

date of the change."
