A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT THAT AGENCIES REESTABLISHED AFTER SUNSET REVIEW BE SUBJECT TO SCHEDULED REVIEW EVERY 6 YEARS; AMENDING SECTION 2-8-122, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 2-8-122, MCA, is amended to read:

"2-8-122. Reestablishment. (1) Any agency scheduled for termination under this part or any subsequent act may be reestablished by the legislature for any period of time specified by law ~~not to exceed 6 years, at the end of which time the legislature shall again review the agency pursuant to 2-8-122 and may again reestablish, modify, or allow the termination of the agency pursuant to this section.~~

(2) No more than one agency may be continued or reestablished in any bill for an act, and the agency shall be mentioned in the bill's title."
