BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the general ~~FEDERAL AND PRIVATE REVENUE~~ fund RESOURCE INDEMNITY TRUST FUND ACCOUNT to the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation the sum of \$591,300 for the biennium ending June 30, 1981, for the rehabilitation of Cooney Dam as set forth in a report prepared for the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation entitled "Rehabilitation of Cooney Dam Spillways" and submitted to the Legislature in January, 1979. ~~FROM THE ABOVE AMOUNT NO MORE THAN \$20,000 MAY BE SPENT UNTIL \$1,150,000 OF FEDERAL REVENUE HAS BEEN SECURED. THE FAILURE TO SECURE SUCH FEDERAL FUNDING SHALL TERMINATE ANY FUNDING OBLIGATIONS HEREIN INCURRED BY THE STATE OF MONTANA AND SHALL CAUSE A REVERSION OF ALL UNEXPENDED FUNDS, BUT NOT LESS THAN \$571,300 TO THE RESOURCE INDEMNITY TRUST FUND ACCOUNT.~~

SENATE STANDING COMMITTEE REPORT
(Finance and Claims)

That House Bill No. 894, third reading bill, be amended as follows:

1. Page 1, line 11.

Strike: "FEDERAL AND PRIVATE REVENUE fund"

Insert: "RESOURCE INDEMNITY TRUST FUND ACCOUNT"

2. Page 1, line 18.

Following: "1979."

Insert: "From the above amount no more than \$20,000 may be spent until \$1,150,000 of federal revenue has been secured. The failure to secure such federal funding shall terminate any funding obligations herein incurred by the State of Montana and shall cause a reversion of all unexpended funds, but not less than \$571,300 to the resource indemnity trust fund account."
