A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT APPROPRIATING MONEY TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO COMPLETE THE EDITING AND PUBLISHING OF THE 1972 CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION PROCEEDINGS; PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the general fund to the Legislative Council \$80,000 for the expenses of editing, proofing, indexing, and publishing the proceedings of the 1972 Constitutional Convention and for the expenses of the committee created by Chapter 373, Laws of 1977, to supervise such editing and publishing.

Section 2. Section 4, Chapter 373, Laws of 1977, is amended to read:

"Section 4. Distribution of copies. (1) The committee shall have printed and delivered to the executive director of the legislative council 1,000 hard-bound copies of the proceedings of the 1972 constitutional convention.

(2) Of these 1,000 copies, 60 copies are to be distributed by the legislative council, free of charge, in the following manner:

- (a) law library -- 4 copies;

- (b) state library -- 10 copies;
 - (c) office of the governor -- 1 copy;
 - (d) office of the lieutenant governor -- 1 copy;
 - (e) office of the secretary of state -- 1 copy;
 - (f) office of the attorney general -- 1 copy;
 - (g) office of the superintendent of public instruction -- 1 copy;
 - (h) office of the state auditor -- 1 copy;
 - (i) supreme court -- 5 copies;
 - (j) each state department -- 1 copy;
 - (k) Montana historical society -- 5 copies;
 - (l) office of the legislative council -- 10 copies;
 - (3) ~~The remaining copies are to be sold to the public at a price to be determined by the committee which will approximate preparation and publication costs. The committee shall set the sales price of the proceedings at an amount sufficient to totally recoup the amount appropriated for the proceedings, including the \$130,000 appropriated by HB 160 of the 45th Legislature. Proceeds from sales of the proceedings shall be deposited in the general fund.~~
- Section 3. Effective date. This act is effective on passage and approval.
