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A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE COUNTIES TO PROVIDE REASONABLE OFFICE SPACE FOR ASSESSORS. APPRAISERS.

AND THEIR STAFFS: AND AMENDING SECTION 15-8-102, MCA."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 15-8-102. MCA, is amended to read:

#15-8-102. County assessor as agent of department -
counties to furnish office space. (1) The county assessors

of the various counties of the state are agents of the

department of revenue for the purpose of locating and

providing the department a description of all taxable

property within the county, together with other pertinent

information, and for the purpose of performing such other

administrative duties as are required for placing taxable

property on the assessment roles. The assessors shall

perform such other duties as are required by law, not in

conflict with the provisions of this subsection.

(2) The county commissioners of the various counties shall provide existing reasonable office space in the county courthouse for use by the county assessor, his deputies and staff, and the state appraiser and staff, if such space is reasonably available. If such space is not reasonably

2 fory--the--department--shall--pay-the-cost-thereof atherwise provided by the county. The department is not liable for any expenses in connection with the use of the space, including, without limitation, costs of rent, utilities, or ianitorial services. Additional personal property required 7 by the department for the assessor to perform his duties as agent of the department shall be provided by the department. 9 (3) The department must provide maps for the use of its agents, showing the private lands owned or claimed in 10 the county and, if surveyed under authority of the United 11 States, the divisions and subdivisions of the survey. Maps 12 of cities and villages or school districts may in like 13 14 manner be provided. The cost of making such maps is a state charge and must be paid from the state general fund.\* 15
