A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$675,000 FROM THE LONG-RANGE BUILDING PROGRAM TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF VETERANS' DOMICILIARY FACILITIES AT TWIN BRIDGES, MONTANA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Appropriation for veterans' facility construction at Twin Bridges. (1) There is appropriated from the long-range building program to the department of administration for the biennium ending June 30, 1981, the sum of \$675,000.

(2) This appropriation is to be used for the design and construction of a 60-bed veterans' domiciliary facility attached to the Twin Bridges veterans' home.
