THE APPROPRIATION IS TO PAY THE AGREED SETTLEMENT WITH SEYMOUR STORCH DATED OCTOBER 26, 1978.

THE APPROPRIATION IS TO REIMBURSE THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS \$61,230 AND THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME \$61,774 TO IMPLEMENT THE AIRPLANE POOL.

IN THE EVENT THE COSTS FOR UTILITIES AND MEDICAL SERVICES EXCEED THE PROJECTED COST FOR THE SAME SERVICES CONTAINED IN THE INITIAL SUPPLEMENTAL REQUEST, THE MANDATED REVERSION OF \$123,200 WILL BE REDUCED BY A LIKE DOLLAR AMOUNT, SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE BUDGET DIRECTOR.

Section 4. Effective date. This act is effective on passage and approval.
