A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE \$1.5
 MILLION FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A GYMNASIUM FOR THE MONTANA
 STATE SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF AND BLIND IN GREAT FALLS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
 Section 1. Appropriation. (1) There is appropriated
 \$1,500,000 to the Board of Public Education for the biennium
 ending June 30, 1981, from the local impact and education
 trust fund account in the earmarked revenue fund, created
 under 90-6-202, for construction of a gymnasium at the
 Montana State School for the Deaf and Blind in Great Falls.
 (2) The appropriation shall be withdrawn from the
 local impact and education trust fund account by the Board
 of Public Education as the progress of construction and the
 construction contract require payments to be made.
