8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Appropriation. (1) There is appropriated  
10 \$1,500,000 to the Board of Public Education for the biennium  
11 ending June 30, 1981, from the local impact and education  
12 trust fund account in the earmarked revenue fund, created  
13 under 90-6-202, for construction of a gymnasium at the  
14 Montana State School for the Deaf and Blind in Great Falls.

15 (2) The appropriation shall be withdrawn from the  
16 local impact and education trust fund account by the Board  
17 of Public Education as the progress of construction and the  
18 construction contract require payments to be made.
