Propula 10 11 WHEREAS, every Montana household needs an adequate Dauly 12 amount of energy in order to live decently in the extreme 13 climatic conditions of the Northern Rocky Mountains; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the cost of an adequate amount of energy is becoming a financial burden for most Montanans and causing 16 17 undue hardship for many households.

21 That the Public Service Commission is requested to take 22 into consideration that a reasonably sufficient amount of 23 energy is the right and necessity of every Montana 24 household.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Public Service

- Commission is requested to adopt as its primary objective
 the insuring of the availability of the least costly form of
 energy to residents of the state and to emphasize this
 objective in the hearings mandated by the National Energy
 Act.
- 6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State 7 shall send a copy of this resolution to each member of the
- 8 Public Service Commission.
