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A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA REQUESTING THE COMMITTEE ON PRIORITIES TO ASSIGN THE APPROPRIATE STANDING COMMITTEE TO STUDY ALTERNATIVE NO-FAULT MOTOR VEHICLE REPARATIONS PLANS AND TO RECOMMEND THE FEASIBILITY OF IMPLEMENTING A NO-FAULT MOTOR VEHICLE REPARATIONS PLAN IN MONTANA, TOGETHER WITH THE NECESSARY LEGISLATION.

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WHEREAS, the Legislature of the state of Montana recognizes that a great number of Montana citizens are interested in a form of no-fault vehicle reparations plan; and

WHEREAS, if feasible, a no-fault reparations plan has the potential of providing many benefits to our society.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: That the Committee on Priorities is requested to assign
the appropriate standing committee to conduct public
hearings on and a study of no-fault motor vehicle
reparations plans.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the committee conducting
the study prepare and present to the 47th Legislature a
report which analyzes the costs and benefits of alternative
plans and recommend the feasibility of implementing a
no-fault motor vehicle reparation plan in Montana, together
