4 A RESOLUTION OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
 5 MONTANA AUTHORIZING CERTAIN LEGISLATIVE OFFICERS AND
 6 EMPLOYEES TO COMPLETE THE BUSINESS OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF
 7 THE 46TH LEGISLATURE, TO PROVIDE COMPENSATION FOR EMPLOYEES
 8 TO PREPARE ANY BUSINESS OF ANY SPECIAL SESSION OF THE 46TH
 9 LEGISLATURE, AND TO PREPARE THE BUSINESS OF THE 47TH
 10 LEGISLATURE.

 12 WHEREAS, the completion of business of the regular
 13 session of the 46th Legislature encompasses the employment
 14 of certain legislative officers and employees of the House
 15 of Representatives; and

16 WHEREAS, the preparation of business of any special
 17 session of the 46th Legislature of the regular session of
 18 the 47th Legislature encompasses the employment of certain
 19 legislative officers and employees of the House of
 20 Representatives.

 22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the payrolls covering each
 12 employment shall be authenticated by the Speaker of the
 13 House of Representatives and the Chief Clerk or Sergeant at
 14 Arms, as appropriate, and the payment of the same shall be
 15 made separate and out of funds appropriated for the regular
 16 session of the 46th Legislature at the rate specified in
 17 House Joint Resolution No. 1, effective January 13, 1979, or
 18 from any new funds appropriated for such purposes.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that legislative officers and
 20 employees for any special session of the 46th Legislature or
 21 the regular session of the 47th Legislature shall be
 22 employed and compensated at the same prescribed rate as
 23 defined in House Joint Resolution No. 1 and letter of
 24 authorization addressed to Diana Dowling dated January 8,
 25 1979, and signed by Representative Jerry Metcalf, Chairman

1 of the House Legislative Administration/Bills and Journal
 2 Committee, until such time as the rates are changed by the
 3 House of Representatives.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution is
 5 effective upon adoption by the House of Representatives.
