DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to reallocate money received from federal mineral leases and to distribute the money to the state highway account, to state equalization aid for schools, and to the Bureau of Mines and Geology, and to require the Bureau of Mines to report to the Legislature.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The state's share of gas, oil, and other mineral royalties under the Federal Mineral Lands Leasing Act will be \$7 million per year.
- 2. The Bureau of Mines will incur minimal costs in preparing and presenting the mandated report to the Legislature.
