AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 22-3-105, MCA, RELATING TO THE COMPENSATION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE MONTANA HISTORICAL SOCIETY.

Section 1. The proposed amendment deletes the reference to the "department head". The "department head" was originally the State Board of Education. The Historical Society was removed from under the direct control of the Board of Education by section 12, Chapter 51, Laws of 1974. There is no longer a "department head" for the Historical Society.
