- (5) The commissioner shall may appoint and employ a field investigator whose primary duty it shall be as directed by the commissioner to make investigations in this state of violations or claimed violations of this code.
- (6) The commissioner may appoint a chief clerk for the insurance department and employ such other assistants and clerks as may be necessary to assist him properly to discharge the duties imposed upon him under this code.
- (7) The commissioner may at any time terminate the appointment, designation, or employment of any such deputy, actuary, chief clark, or other employee.
- (8) The commissioner may from time to time contract for and procure, on a fee or part-time basis, or both, such actuarial, technical, or other professional services as he may require for the discharge of his dutles.
- (9) The compensation of all such personnel so appointed, employed, or contracted for by him shall be as fixed by the commissioner but in the aggregate shall not exceed current funds appropriated by the legislature to the insurance department or otherwise currently available for the purpose."
