In compliance with a written request received January 5, 19 79, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for Senate Bill 28 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly.

Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act providing that grants from an appropriation made by House Bill 708, laws of 1978, for the solid waste management project need not be repaid.

ASSUMPTION:

Expenditures from the Renewable Resource Development Clearance Fund for grants for the solid waste management project will total \$200,000 for FY78 and \$100,000 for FY79.

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill No. 708 enacted by the Forty-Fifth Legislature appropriated monies for various projects under the Renewable Resource Development Program, to include a grant for the solid waste management project of \$200,000 in FY 1978 and \$100,000 in FY 1979. Enactment of the proposed legislation would allow grant recipients (cities and counties) to not repay the grants which will decrease the balance of the Renewable Resource Development Clearance Fund Account by approximately \$300,000 over the biennium.
