13 "87-2-701. Special licenses. (1) Any applicant
14 resident as defined in 87-2-102 who is will be 12 years of
15 age or older prior to September 15 of the season for which
16 the license is issued and is a nonresident as defined by
17 87-2-102; or any applicant person not a resident as defined
18 in 87-2-102a who is the holder of a Class B-2 nonresident
19 combination license may apply for a special license which,
20 in the judgment of the department, is to be issued and shall
21 pay the following fees therefor:

22 (a) moose--resident, \$25; nonresident, \$125;
23 (b) mountain goat--resident, \$15; nonresident, \$75;
24 (c) mountain sheep--resident, \$25; nonresident, \$125;
25 (d) antelope--resident, \$5;

1 (e) grizzly bear--resident, \$25; nonresident, \$125;
2 (f) black or brown bear--nonresident, \$50.
3 (2) In the event a holder of a valid special grizzly
4 bear license kills a grizzly bear, he must purchase a trophy
5 license for a fee of \$25 within 10 days after date of kill.
6 Such trophy license shall authorize the holder to possess
7 and transport said trophy.

8 (3) In the event that the number of valid resident
9 applications for licenses exceeds the number of licenses
