6 NONRESIDENT TRAPPER'S LICENSE, WITH FEES THEREFOR, AND

7 INCREASING THE RESIDENT TRAPPER'S LICENSE FEE; AMENDING

8 SECTION 87-2-601, MCA, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Section 87-2-601, MCA, is amended to read:

12 "87-2-601. Class C--~~resident~~ trapper's license. Any

13 resident, as defined in 87-2-102, upon making application

14 and paying the sum of \$10 ~~125~~ to the department, shall be

15 entitled to a resident trapper's license which shall

16 authorize the holder thereof to trap fur-bearing animals and

17 hunt bobcat within the state of Montana at such times and in

18 such manner as may be lawful so to do under the laws of the

19 state and the regulations of the department and at such

20 places as may be designated in said license."

21 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Class C-2--nonresident

22 trapper's license. Any person not a resident, as defined in

23 87-2-102, upon making application to the department and

24 paying a fee of \$100 is entitled to a nonresident trapper's

25 license which authorizes the holder thereof to trap

1 fur-bearing animals within the state at such times and in

2 such manner as may be lawful under the laws of the state and

3 the regulations of the department and at such places as may

4 be designated on the license.

5 Section 3. Codification instructions. Section 2 of

6 this act is intended to be codified as an integral part of

7 Title 87, chapter 2, part 6, and the provisions of Title 87,

8 chapter 2 apply to section 2 of this act.

9 Section 4. Effective date. This act is effective May

10 1, 1980.
