5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 6 60-4-204 AND 60-4-205, MCA, RELATING TO THE SALE TO THE 7 ORIGINAL OWNER OF INTERESTS IN REAL PROPERTY HELD BY THE

DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 60-4-204. MCA. is amended to read:

"60-4-204. Option of original owner or-successor-in

interest to purchase at sale price. The owner from whom the

interest was originally acquired or-his-successor-in

interest shall have the option to purchase the interest by

offering therefor an amount of money equal to the highest

bid received for the interest at the sale. The offer shall

be sent to the department by registered or certified mail

within 10 days from the date of the sale.*

Section 2. Section 60-4-205, MCA, is amended to read:

#60-4-205. Private sale if no bid or offer. (1) If,

after proper notice is published, the department receives

neither bid at public sale nor offer from the original owner

of-his-successor-in-interest, it may at any time thereafter

sell the interest at private sale. At the sale, the

department may accept as the purchase price an amount of
money not less than 90% of the appraised value.

3 (2) Title to an interest may not pass from the state
4 until the purchaser has paid the full amount of the purchase
5 price into the state treasury to the credit of the
6 department.
