5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION  
6 50-60-605, MCA, TO AUTHORIZE TEMPORARY ELECTRICAL  
7 CONNECTIONS BY POWER SUPPLIERS WITHOUT INSPECTION."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
10            Section 1. Section 50-60-605, MCA, is amended to read:  
11            "50-60-605. Power supplier not to energize  
12 installation without inspection tag. Individuals, firms,  
13 cooperatives, corporations, or municipalities selling  
14 electricity are power suppliers. ~~Except for temporary~~  
15 ~~connections which the department may authorize by rule for a~~  
16 ~~period not exceeding 14 days without a preconnection~~  
17 ~~inspection.~~ Power power suppliers may not connect with or  
18 energize an electrical installation under this part unless  
19 the owner or a licensed electrical contractor has delivered  
20 to the power supplier an inspection tag covering the  
21 installation, issued by the department of administration."
