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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 69-12-102. MCA, is amended to read: 10 #69-12-102. Scope of chapter -- exemptions. (1) This 11 chapter does not affect:

- (a) motor vehicles used in carrying property consisting of agricultural commodities (not including manufactured products thereof) if the motor vehicles are not used in carrying other property or passengers for compensation;
- (b) the operation of school buses which are used in conveying pupils or other students enrolled in classes to and from district or other schools or in transportation movements related to school activities which are sponsored or supervised by school authorities;

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

Senate Bill 70 exempts transportation of buildings (not mobile homes) from the jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- Carriers with authority to transport buildings only will not be required to pay Annual Report fees or Equipment registration fees.
- Carriers holding authority to transport buildings and other commodities will reduce number of vehicles registered.
- Number of carriers holding authority to transport buildings, and equipment used in the transportation, will remain constant in the next biennium.

STATEMENT OF INTENT RE: SB 70

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The legislature intends that persons engaged in the transportation of buildings other than mobile homes be permitted to offer such transportation service statewide basis rather than on a regional basis. Rules adopted under this bill shall provide for the reissuance of certificates of public convenience and necessity to those persons engaged solely in the transportation of buildings and for the modification of certificates issued to persons authorized to engage in other activities in addition building transportation.

Insert: "(2) The provisions of this section shall apply only to those licensed motor carriers who have specifically identified the moving of buildings or certain types of buildings as an area of authorization on their present public service commission certification or to those motor carriers operating under an authority broad enough to include the moving of buildings who have been actively engaged in the business of moving buildings for a period of 2 years prior to July 1, 1979. For purposes of this subsection, a motor carrier has been actively engaged in the business of moving buildings if the moving of buildings has constituted a substantial part of his business during the 2-year period prior to July 1, 1979."
