 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 61-9-417, MCA, is amended to read:
 10 "61-9-417. Headgear required for ~~minor~~ motorcycle
 11 riders. An operator and passenger ~~under 16 years of age~~ of
 12 any motorcycle operated upon the streets or highways of this
 13 state shall wear protective headgear upon the head. The
 14 headgear shall meet standards established by the department
 15 of justice."
