Section 1. Section 61-9-417, MCA, is amended to read:

"61-9-417. Headgear required for minor motorcycle
riders. An operator and passenger under-18-years-of -age of
any motorcycle operated upon the streets or highways of this
state shall wear protective headgear upon the head. The
headgear shall meet standards established by the department
of justice."
